

POLICY ON COOKIES

Method of use of cookies in Italy

Following changes made by the Directive 2009/136/EC on Privacy and Electronic Communication, implemented by Legislative Decree 28/5/2012, no. 69, of the Provision issued by the Italian Data Protection Authority “Identification of simplified procedures for information and acquisition of consent for the use of cookies” dated May 8 2014, operators of websites that use cookies or other tracking technologies must inform the user about the types of cookies used by the site and request prior approval for the dispatch of these cookies to the user's device and/or access to information saved in them.

Why Ciat Italia uses cookies

The Ciat Italia website uses cookies for a number of reasons. Cookies are small text files that are saved by your browser and enable data from web pages and browser sessions to be stored. Ciat Italia uses some “first party cookies” – generated and used by the Ciat Italia website– and also “third party cookies” – generated on our site by third parties.

Cookies allow us to save each element of your navigation as soon as you enter the site and show the most suitable content depending on the options you choose and based on your navigation. Cookies help us to understand what approach to adopt on our site, in order to make your navigation more efficient.

Cookies are capable of storing only text content, always anonymous and usually encrypted. CIAT Italy will never store any personal information in a cookie.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files generated by the websites you visit, which retain the session data that could be used later at the site. The data allows the site to keep your information among the pages and also to analyse the way you interact with the site.

Cookies are safe – they can only retain information that is inserted by the browser, related to access to the browser itself or included in the page requested. They cannot be transformed into codes and cannot be used to access your computer. If a website encrypts information in cookies, only the website can read that information.

What kind of cookies do we use?

There are two different types of cookies: Session and Persistent. They are used for different reasons and contain different types of information.

Session Cookies contain information that is used in your current browser session. These cookies are automatically deleted when you close your browser. Nothing is stored on your computer after the period of use of the site.

Persistent Cookies are used to maintain information that is used in the period between one access to the website and the next. This data allows sites to recognise you as an already known client or visitor and they adapt accordingly. “Persistent”

cookies have a duration that is determined by the site and can vary from a few minutes to several years.

Third party cookies

Google Analytics cookies The website uses Google Analytics exclusively for statistical purposes. The cookies in question collect information in aggregate form in order to monitor and analyse access to all areas of the site. The information generated by the cookie about website use is communicated to Google Inc., whose website <http://www.google.com/intl/it/analytics/privacyoverview.html> is expressly referred to for more details and to disable its saving on the user's terminal as its use for navigation on our site is entirely optional.

Linkedin and Youtube cookies. The Linkedin and Youtube cookies are not present on the Ciat Italia website and are not sent by the latter to the user's terminal. These cookies, not indispensable in any way for navigation on the Ciat Italia website, are activated only when the related website is accessed, by clicking on the IN, YT icon, i.e. by entering the respective social network websites, which are referred to in order to have more detail and to disable their storage on the user's terminal:

Why use cookies?

We use cookies to make using the Ciat Italia website simpler and to better adapt our products to your interests and needs. Cookies can also be used to help speed up your future experiences and activities on our website. We also use cookies to compile anonymous aggregate statistics that allow us to understand how people use our site and to help us improve the structure and content of this site.

Method for notifying the user and obtaining consent

When you visit the website for the first time, a banner is displayed at the top of the screen to inform you that CIAT Italia uses cookies as described in this Policy on this website. The banner asks the user if he/she wants more information and includes a link to open the corresponding page. If this notification is ignored and use of the website continues, Ciat Italia stores a cookie on the user's computer to record this choice and successive navigation of the website is considered as consent to the use of cookies used on the site in question. The notification banner is not displayed again on the screen during future visits to the website, but users have the possibility of removing the cookies at any time through browser settings.

Management of cookies: blocking and elimination

The actions to adopt are different for each browser. You can find instructions in the help menu of your browser. If you use multiple computers in different locations, make sure that each browser is set to meet your preferences.

Through your browser, you can also view the cookies that are on your computer, delete some or eliminate them all.

Cookies are simply text files, so you can easily open them and read their content. The data contained in them is often encrypted or has a numeric key corresponding to a web session, so they often do not make sense except to the website which wrote them.

If you disable the cookies that we use, you may not be able to activate certain features necessary to create a recording. Disabling cookies also deactivates the monitoring of your progress at the site, but the analytical code for the recognition of your visit will not be blocked.
